Check in Deadline: Rider's who have not collected their plate/ checked in by Saturday, 12:00 will not be included on the Start List. Altering, cutting, blocking with a computer device or placing of unauthorized stickers or sponsor logos on race number plate is not permitted.

Personal insurance coverage is not provided by the Organisers. Insurance is normally provided with the licence purchase.

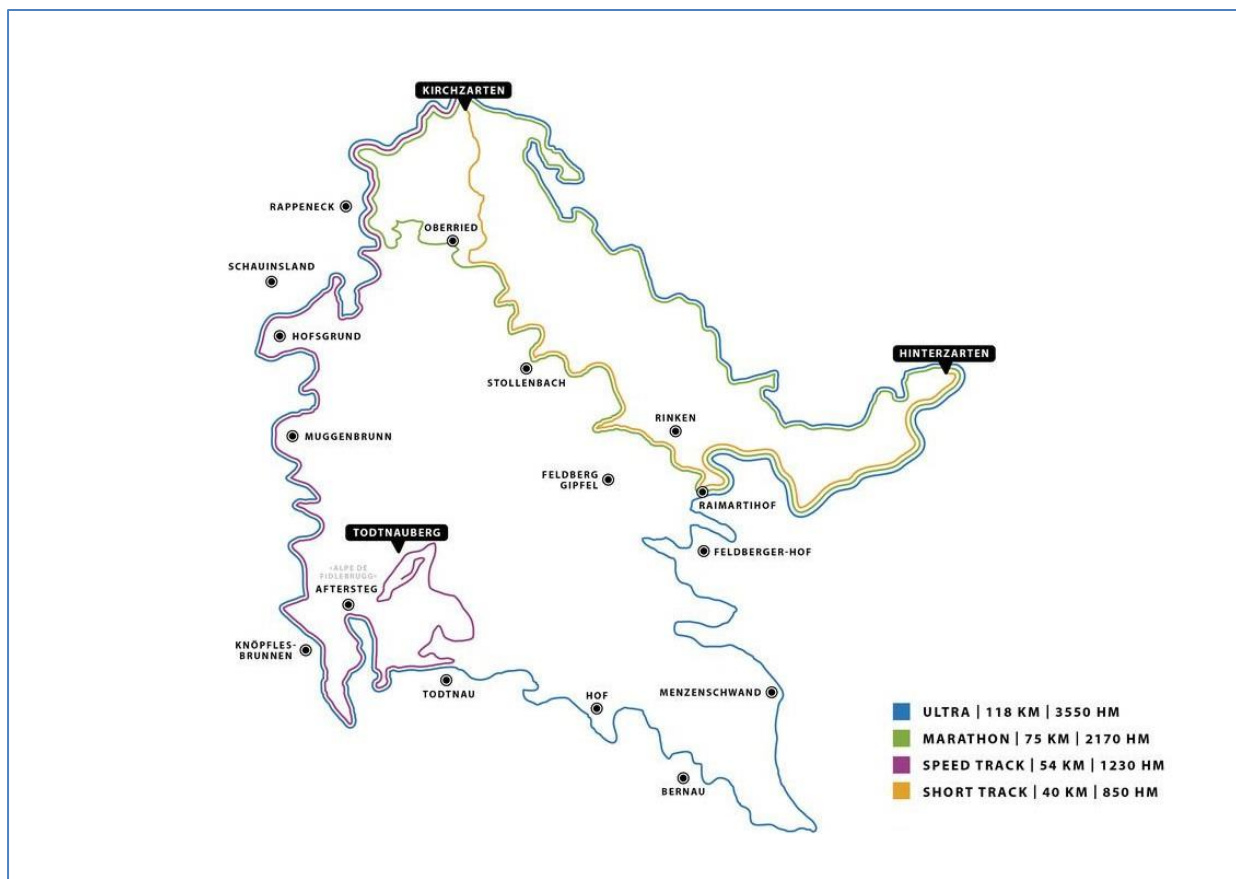
Entry fee insurance can be purchased during the registration process.

03.6 DISCLAIMER AND LIABILITY RELEASE

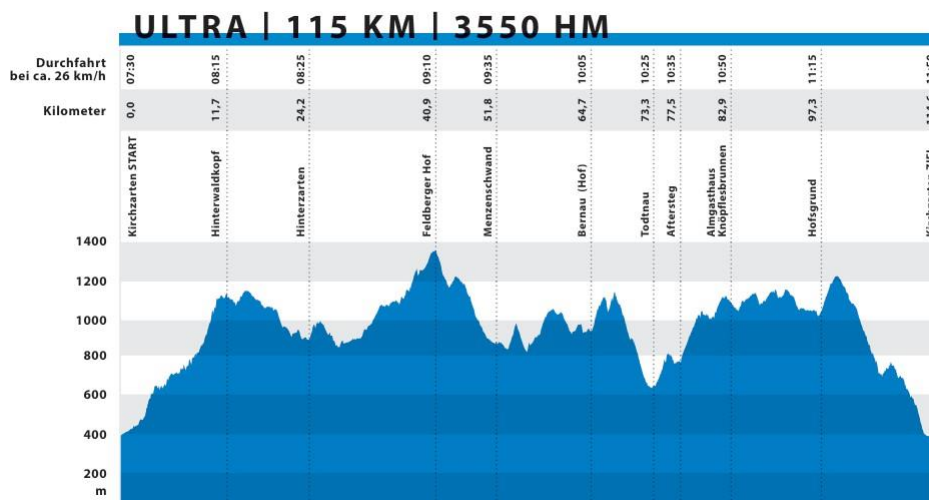

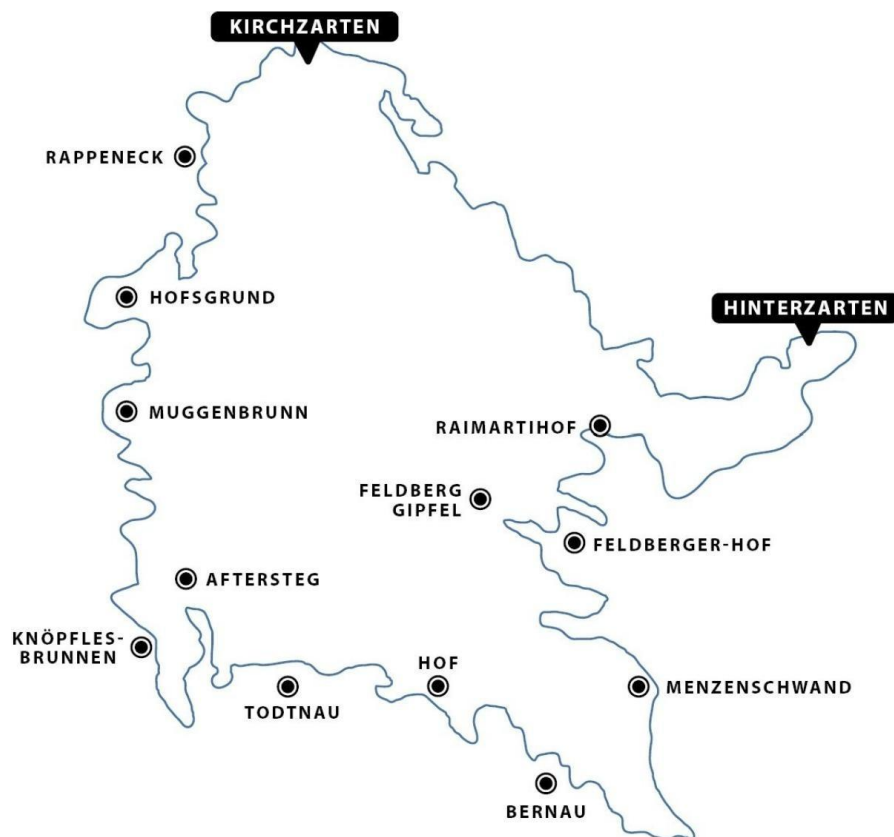
04 RACE LOGISTICS

Racers must carry their timing chips on their bike.

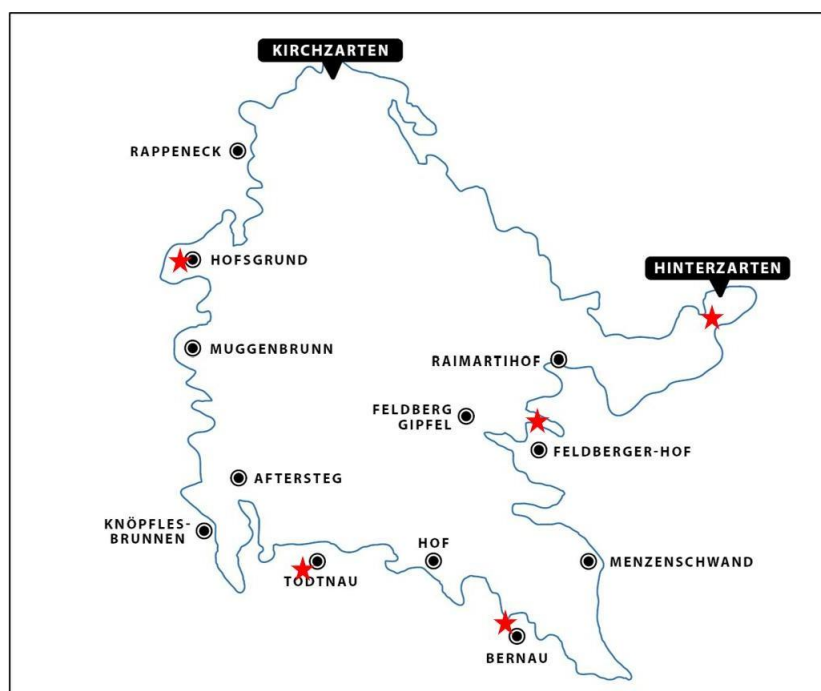
Timing chips will be with your race number.

04.5 TV Operations

Drones and camera operatives using quads and motorbikes will be operational throughout the race.

They will not interfere with the race in any way.

04.6 Feed Zones and Technical Assistance Zones



There are five Feed and Technical Assistance Zones on the course, all clearly marked for team staff with "UCI Feed / Tech Zone". All zones are easily accessible for team staff via public roads.

Feed – Tech Assistance Zones Regulation:

Access to the UCI Feed and Technical Assistance Zones will be given only to authorized personnel. Technical assistance is allowed in the provided technical zones only, in boxes out of the race course in order not to hamper the competitors. Bicycle spare parts and tools for the bikes must be put down in the technical assistance zones. In each zone, feeding and technical assistance can be done.

In addition to the technical assistance in the provided technical zones, technical assistance is allowed outside of these zones between competitors belonging to the same team or same representation. The competitors can carry tools and spare parts with them as long as these do not pose any danger to themselves and to others.

Warm up Zone

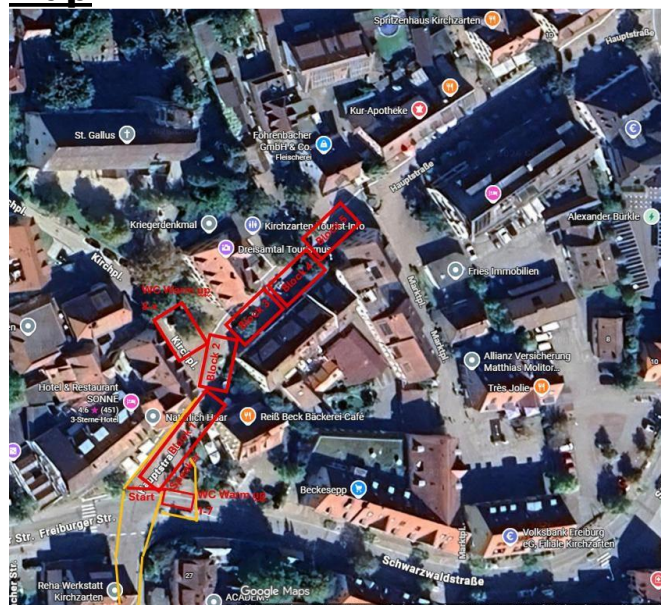
There will be two Warm up Zones that are clearly marked. Warm up Zone 1 is for the Top 7 Elite Men and Women riders. It is located opposite of the start line. Warm up Zone 2 is for all riders as of start position 8 as well as for all Master License riders. This zone is located behind Starting Grid 1.

05.4 FINISH

The Prize Giving Ceremonies will take place at 15:30 for the top 3 Elite Men and top 3 Elite Women as well as the top 3 Master Men and top 3 Master Women at the Finish Area. The winner, the second and the third placed riders shall be ready for the flower ceremony that shall be conducted under the responsibility of the chief of the commissaries panel.

06 RULES

06.1 RACE RULES

The event will be under UCI rules.

Littering is strictly prohibited. No on-board cameras permitted.

The number and the chip, provided by the Organisation, has to be fixed to the handlebars and on the back of the participant in a clearly visible manner. The number cannot be modified or changed in any way.

Bikers must wear a hard safety approved helmet which must be kept fastened throughout the race.

All bikers must carry with them a puncture kit.

Bikers are required to move aside to allow faster bikers to overtake.

Participants who quit the race have to give such communication to the Organisation and hand the number back to the next security controller along the route.

It is severely prohibited to use any form of electric or electronic support on the bike itself.

06.2 ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

All riders entered into the event must comply with all Anti-Doping regulations and procedures if asked to do so. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from that event and further penalisation as deemed appropriate by WBDS.

WBDS will follow all German Anti-Doping rules, protocols and procedures. It is the responsibility of all riders, teams, coaches to read and follow all advice and documents provided by the UCI and WADA Antidoping rules

07 UCI MTB TEAMS

07.1 UCI MTB MARATHON TEAM BENEFITS

These benefits are exclusively available to UCI MTB Marathon Teams registered with the UCI:

- Paddock Space: Allocation of 30 m² for all HERO UCI Marathon World Cup rounds upon request via info@heroucimarathonworldcup.com, 30 days before each round. Additional square meters can be requested for 20,00 Euro per m².
- Team Standings: Inclusion in the HERO UCI Marathon World Cup Team standings. The UCI marathon team ranking is calculated by adding the points of the 4 best placed men and the 4 best placed women of each UCI TEAM in the UCI XCM individual ranking.
- Accreditation Passes: 4 Accreditation passes for registered UCI MTB TEAMS valid for the entire 2026 HERO UCI Marathon World Cup season for the Start/Finish area and the dedicated areas in the Feed and Technical Zones. The passes were handed out during the Team Managers' Meeting of the first round.

Please note: Accreditation and Team Ranking will not be provided to Teams not registered with the UCI.

07.2 FINISH AREA ACCESS

- Accreditation Passes: 4 Accreditation passes for registered UCI MTB TEAMS valid for the entire 2026 HERO UCI Marathon World Cup season for the Start/Finish area and the dedicated areas in the Feed and Technical Zones. The passes were handed out during the Team Managers' Meeting of the first round.

Please note: Only UCI Teams will receive an accreditation for the Finish Area. Teams not registered with the UCI can request one accreditation pass for the restricted area.

07.3 ARRIVAL AREA

The arrival area of each round is divided into three distinct zones, reserved for the respective categories and arranged in order of proximity to the finish line:

MEDIA AREA

This space is reserved exclusively for press and photographers accredited by the HWC organization, who must be identifiable by their official pass and armband. The "Press" armband must be strictly returned to the organization at the end of each round. Requirements for the top three finishers (Elite Men and Women):

- To remain within the Media Area immediately after crossing the finish line to allow for official video footage and photography
- To promptly take part in "flash interviews" for television broadcasters and official race media channels

UCI TEAM AREA

This space is reserved exclusively for Teams officially registered with the UCI. Access is granted only to personnel wearing the organization's accreditation, which must be clearly visible.

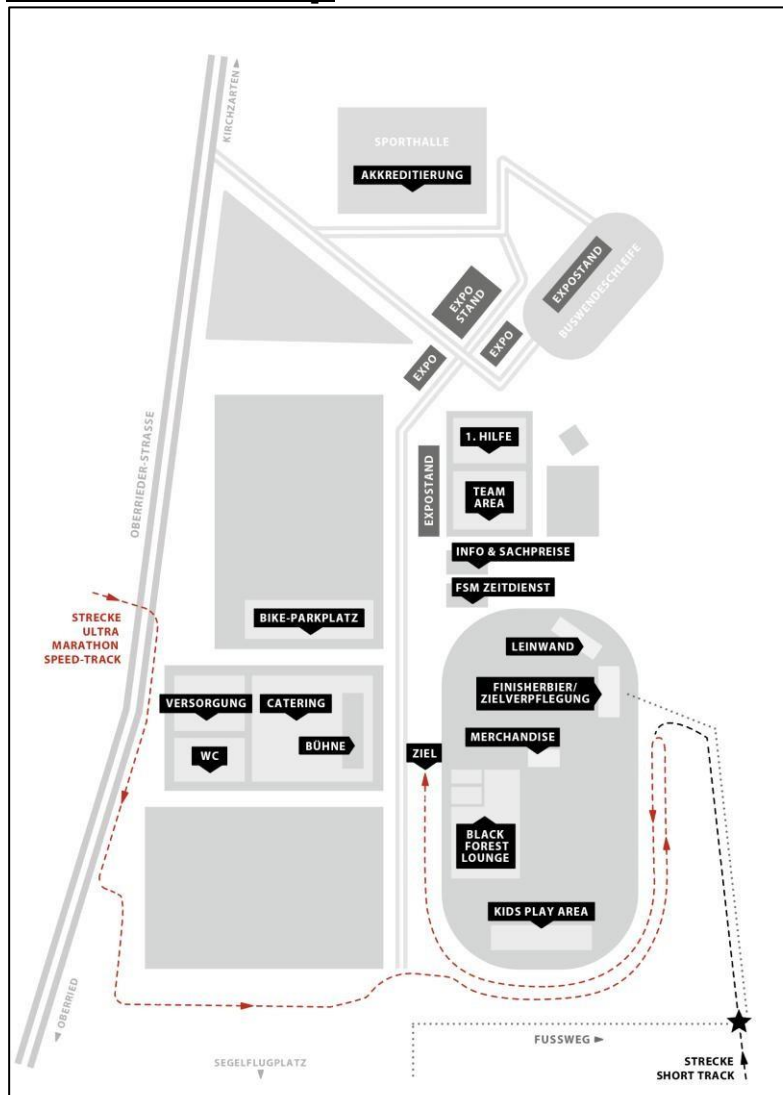
AREA TEAM

This space is reserved exclusively for Teams not registered with the UCI.

Sanctions: Failure to comply with the above regulations - specifically regarding the media obligations of the top three finishers and the correct use of accreditation - will result in sanctions in accordance with the current disciplinary code.

Arrival by train

The Dreisamtal and the High Black Forest are easily accessible by train. Kirchgarten is connected to the Breisgau S-Bahn. Bicycle transportation is free of charge within the available capacity. If you also use long-distance trains for your journey, please inform yourself about the bicycle transportation regulations.

Arrival by car

You can reach the Dreisamtal by car via the A5 or the A81 highways, as well as the B31 federal road. Kirchgarten is connected to its own exit on the B31.

08.3 ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation arrangements for the event are being managed by the Tourist Office Dreisamtal. They will gladly assist all teams where they can. They are best placed to know which accommodation is available in the Black Forest.

Parking is located outside the sports stadium Kirchgarten and clearly marked from all incoming roads to Kirchgarten. Additional parking spaces are available in Kirchgarten's industrial zones Fischerrain and Keltenbuck.

Security will be in place at the village and team area from Friday – Sunday **during nighttime**. *Please do not leave bikes or equipment unattended at any time. Although surveillance will be in place individuals are responsible for their personal property at all times.*

The **Race Office** is situated at the Accreditation Center. During the race weekend, UCI members will have their position inside the Race Office.

09 MEDICAL

09.1 EMERGENCY RESPONSE

The Mountain Rescue of the Black Forest will be in charge of the Emergency Response and will be in attendance during competition times. The medical team will consist of doctors, paramedics and first responders. These resources will be located on courses as well as at the event medical centre. The Medical Centre is situated in the Sports Stadium.
