



2026 HERO UCI CROSS-COUNTRY MARATHON WORLD CUP: LET THE INTERNATIONAL GAMES BEGIN – IN CALPE

The HERO Costa Blanca presented by Millennium Luxury Properties will take place in Calpe on 21 February 2026, opening the second edition of the mountain bike cross-country marathon series. The Press Conference was held in the Spanish city and featured local authorities and athletes to present the circuit's novelties.

The race will be broadcast on TV across four continents.

Calpe, Spain – 3 February 2026 – This morning's press conference was held at the Casa Nova in Calpe and marked the official start of the second edition of the international **HERO UCI Cross-country Marathon World Cup**. The race will be held in Calpe, on the Costa Blanca, on Saturday, 21 February 2026.

At the end of February, the Elite of mountain bike cross-country marathon (XCM) will compete against the backdrop of turquoise and azure waters and sun-kissed beaches and cliffs.

A number of athletes, as well as the mayors of the five municipalities which will see the cyclists race across their towns, took part in the press conference to share their impressions on the start of the 2026 HERO UCI Cross-country Marathon World Cup with the press. The series opener in Calpe is not only a high-performance sports event but also showcases the local area.

THREE JAM-PACKED DAYS

Calpe is ready to welcome **160 Elite and Master License cyclists from 26 countries and 4 continents – as well as amateur cyclists** – who will test their mettle on the two race tracks: the 82-km one boasting 2,700 elevation gain (hm) and the 50-km course boasting 1,400 hm. The race routes will take cyclists across the Costa Blanca's breathtaking landscapes – the single tracks spanning Calpe, Benissa, and the other municipalities will test the athletes' physical fitness as well as their cycling technique.

The programme kicks off in the **HERO Village**, with stands welcoming athletes and fans alike on Thursday, 19 February between 14:00 and 17:00, and on Friday, 20 February between 10:00 and 17:00. The official presentation of the 2026 UCI XCM Teams will also take place on Friday, at 15:30. This will be followed by the **HERO Race Talk** at 16:00 – high-level athletes will take the floor to share their impressions in the run-up to the first round of the series.

On Saturday, the Elite Men will kick off at 8:00 from Parc de la Creativitat, followed by the Elite Women at 8:10. The Master cyclists will head off at 8:20 and can choose between the Elite "long" course or the 50-km alternative boasting 1,400 hm – which could be the right choice for those who still haven't trained their legs enough in February for long distances. The first Elite Men are set to return to **Calpe** around 12:00, followed by the Elite Women and Master cyclists. The event will be rounded off at 13:00 by the Award Ceremony to celebrate the winners of the HERO Costa Blanca.

The organisers have thought of everything – so, while the athletes race to cross the finish line on the climbs of the Costa Blanca, the HEROes of the future will 'compete' on the **HERO Kids Costa Blanca** on **Saturday, 21 February at 9:30**. A great opportunity to show the beauty of mountain biking to even the youngest in the crowd.

THE STARS OF THE RACE

David Valero Serrano – also an accomplished cross-country Olympic (XCO) athlete with a bronze medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, silver at the 2022 UCI Mountain Bike World Championships, and winner of an XCO UCI World Cup round as well as countless national races – took part in the press conference. He was joined by **Luis Martinez**, two-time Spanish XCM Under 23 Champion. Both Spaniards represent the **Klimatiza Orbea Team**. **Raul Rodriguez**, three-time Spanish Champion, also participated.

"Local HERO" **Sophie Johnson** – European XCM Master Champion and winner of the 2025 Südtirol Dolomites 2025 in Italy in the Master Licence category – completed the 4-strong press team.

These athletes are just some of the faces that will take part in the first round of the international series on 21 February in Calpe.

David Valero Serrano - Klimatiza Orbea Team: "Being able to compete in a marathon and have a World Cup is extremely important to me. At the end of the day, it's a fixed and global event, which will help the discipline grow and increase the number of followers. What's more, the great thing about the HERO World Cup is that both professionals and amateurs can take part in an XCM World Cup race. I've set an ambitious goal this year: I'll try to compete to qualify in the overall HERO World Cup ranking. The truth is that I'm lucky that two of the stages are being held in Spain. The World Cup's start in Calpe really motivates me and I'm really thrilled about it. I'm not very familiar with the terrain, although I do know it from training and watching races. The final stage, La Tramun, is a brand-new race with a huge impact. I've always wanted to compete in it and, if all goes well, this year my wish will come true. I've competed in XCO races both in Italy and Elba and, while I haven't run a marathon there, I think it will contribute considerably to grow in the discipline. The truth is that I'm very happy and thrilled that this XCM World Cup is taking place because I think it will represent a big leap forward for the discipline."
